On Time

The first lesson begins each day at 8.45 am promptly and students are expected to be at school by the first bell at 8.40am.

Parents we need your support with this issue. Please ensure that you make arrangements for your daughter to be at school on time each day. There are far too many girls dropped off late by parents. Being on time is a requirement and teaches students responsibility. No employer tolerates continued lateness and the Home School Liaison Officer will be talking this term to the parents of girls who are frequently late in the morning. We seek your cooperation with this important issue.

Front of School

The pick-up and drop off zone at the front of the school is only meant for a maximum of one minute stops while you safely collect or drop off your daughter. Many parents are extremely frustrated that parents don't park properly or safely and/or remain there for extended periods of time.

They have asked me to pass on their concerns to all parents. Please be respectful of others and the safety of all students by parking correctly and within the time limit.

Uniform

Auburn Girls High School has a uniform that was designed to be smart, comfortable and suitable by students, staff and parents. It is a requirement that all girls be in the correct uniform at all times.

The uniform of the school requires students from Years 7 to Year 10 to wear **charcoal grey** pants if they prefer rather than the skirt.

ONLY YEAR 11 AND 12 STUDENTS ARE TO WEAR BLACK PANTS.

Students who are required to wear long sleeves are to wear the long sleeved school blouse. Girls are NOT to wear short sleeved blouses with coloured undershirts.

Students who have an acceptable reason to wear an item out of uniform must being a note before school to their Deputy Principal.

Girls who require assistance with uniform should see Ms Matta.

The current school uniform was designed and developed after extensive consultation with the parents, students and staff of AGHS in 2016. Parents, you must ensure your daughter's uniform complies with the school's uniform requirement.

AGHS UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All students of Auburn Girls High School are required to wear the full school uniform as decided by the Parent & Citizen Association along with the school community of AGHS. The school uniform promotes a sense of pride and belonging to AGHS. The `Core Rules for all NSW government schools' indicates the NSW government expects all students to follow the school's uniform policy.

The school uniform was redesigned in 2016 in consultation with staff, students, parents and the community. Extensive student input into the style ensures the uniform is contemporary, comfortable and culturally suitable.

ALL items of uniform must be purchased from Oz Fashions (115/127 Parramatta Rd Granville).

Please note that students who need to wear long sleeves MUST wear the school's long sleeved blouse.

Junior (Years 7 to 10) School Uniform

Skirt Checked tartan skirt (green, grey and white) in 2 possible lengths – knee and full

length

Shirt: White with green piping- long or short sleeve - pocket embroidered with school

crest

Pants Dark grey school approved style form the uniform shop only

Jumper Grey embroidered with school crest

College Jacket Black with grey sleeves embroidered with school crest

Blazer Grey embroidered with school crest

Socks Black/white ankle or knee length

Stockings Black

Hijab White or black only (no patterns) shoulder length

Woollen scarf (winter) Grey embroidered with school crest

Shoes Black leather school shoes covering the entire top of the foot up to the ankle

Senior (Years 11-12) School Uniform

Skirt Black skirt in 2 possible lengths – knee and full length

Shirt: White with green piping- long or short sleeve - pocket embroidered with school

Pants Black school approved style form the uniform shop only

Jumper Grey embroidered with school crest

College Jacket Black with grey sleeves embroidered with school crest

Yr 12 Jersey Embroidered with school crest

Blazer Grey embroidered with school crest

Socks Black/white ankle or knee length

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Stockings Black

Hijab White or black only (no patterns) shoulder length only

Woollen scarf (winter) Grey embroidered with school crest

Shoes Black leather school shoes covering the entire top of the foot up to the ankle

On ALL days except Tuesday (Years 8-11)

Students must wear fully enclosed, laced up, leather shoes. If they do not wear fully enclosed leather shoes you will not be able to participate in Science and TAS activities







Sport Uniform

Shirt and shorts Polo shirt and shorts official design from shop only

Socks White

Tracksuit Black jacket and pants – official design from uniform shop only

Shoes Leather sport shoes or joggers

On Tuesdays (Years 8-11) and practical Physical Education lessons:

Students must wear fully enclosed leather sport shoes (runners). Canvas shoes are **not** sport shoes.







Jewellery

Students may wear minimal jewellery – watch, small earrings (small sleepers or studs), plain necklace, one plain ring.
